### Overall context and economic development 2014-2017

- Main factors affecting the performance of the Inland Navigation sector (IWT)
  - Adverse hydro-meteorological conditions
  - Limited recovery of main sectors using IWT(primary & secondary)
  - Inland waterway infrastructure still inadequate
- However the market share remain at around 6% (85% Rhine; 15% Danube)
- 13% average increase in passenger on cruise vessels





#### **Inland Waterways Naiades II programme**

- •The <u>NAIADES II</u> mid-term report presents progress achieved up to 2017 and the on-going actions for implementing NAIADES II until 2020. The report specifically focused on the six key areas of intervention:
- Quality infrastructure
- Quality through innovation
- Smooth functioning of the market
- Environmental quality through low emissions
- Skilled workforce and quality jobs
- Integration of inland navigation into the multimodal logistics chain

- European Inland waterways transport platform

•55 actions covering infrastructure, RIS, innovation
