2. Workshop "Building up a solid international regulatory framework aimed at increasing the efficiency and safety of inland water transport"

Following the decision of the Working Party at its fifty-eighth session, delegations are invited to take part in the workshop dedicated to the international regulatory framework for inland water transport. The workshop will address:

- (a) The efficiency of international conventions relevant to inland navigation and UNECE resolutions and possibilities how to improve the promotion and monitoring of the implementation of mandatory instruments;
- (b) The need for updating the existing legal instruments as foreseen the strategy of the Inland Transport Committee until 2030;
- (c) Potential new legal instruments to further facilitate the growth and use of inland waterways, pleasure navigation and tourism and increase the sustainability of transport.

SC.3/WP.3 may wish to provide recommendations to the Working Party on Inland Water Transport (SC.3) on the implementation of the Strategy of the Inland Transport Committee (ITC) till 2030 and Policy Recommendation No. 2 of the White Paper on the Progress, Accomplishments and Future of Sustainable Inland Water Transport.

Member States and other stakeholders are invited to report on the current progress in inland waterway infrastructure development projects.

4. Standardization of technical and safety requirements in inland navigation

(a) European Code for Inland Waterways (resolution No. 24, revision 5)

The Working Party may wish to take note of the progress made in the preparation of the sixth revision of the European Code for Inland Waterways (CEVNI) by the CEVNI Expert Group: (a) the reports of its thirty-sixth and thirty-seventh meetings held online on 8 February and 13 April 2021 and (b) the amendment proposals agreed by the CEVNI Expert Group at its thirty-seventh meeting (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2021/14).

SC.3/WP.3 may wish to take note of the outcome of its special session on CEVNI to be held on 22 June 2021 back-to-back with its fifty-ninth session and approve the decisions made at the special session.

The Working Party may wish to consider and preliminarily approve the draft CEVNI 6 in the three official languages based on the text prepared by the secretariat (Informal document SC.3/WP.3 No. 11 (2021)) and transmit this to SC.3 for the final adoption.

SC.3/WP.3 may wish to continue discussion on the draft proposal for a model waste water log as set out in ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2021/3.

The Working Party may wish to take note of the amendments to the Police Regulations for the Navigation of the Rhine (RPNR) adopted by the Central Commission for the Navigation of the Rhine at its autumn session in 2020 (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2021/15).

SC.3/WP.3 may wish to continue the discussion of a new draft chapter "Special provisions applicable to electric vessel propulsion" to the annex to resolution No. 61, based on the proposal by the Danube Commission and the feedback received by the secretariat (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/2020/3, ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2020/7 and ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2021/17).

SC.3/WP.3 may wish to discuss the proposal on the additional categorization of waste generated on board inland navigation vessels (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/2020/29) and decide as appropriate.

Member States and river commissions are invited to inform SC.3/WP.3 on the progress reached and the current activities aimed at the prevention of pollution of inland waterways from vessels.

(d) Modernization and greening of the inland waterway fleet in Europe

5. Promotion of River Information Services and other Information and Communication Technologies in inland navigation

(a) Guidelines and Criteria for Vessel Traffic Services on Inland Waterways (annex to resolution No. 58)

The Working Party will be informed about the ongoing work of the International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) on the revision of the Recommendation 0120 (V-120) "Vessel Traffic Services in Inland Waters". SC.3/WP.3 may wish to continue discussion on updating resolution No. 58 and decide as appropriate.

(b) Booklet "River Information Services in the region of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe"

The Working Party may wish to preliminarily approve the draft and provide further guidance to the secretariat.

The Working Party may wish to continue discussion on updating provisions of the annex to resolution No. 31 based on the standards for qualifications in inland navigation professional requirements, included in the European Standard for Qualification in Inland Navigation (ES-QIN) and national regulations of member States.
